Patient grabs woman doc by hair, bangs head

HYDERABAD

Amid the nationwide call for ensuring the safety of doctors in the wake of the rape and murder at Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, a junior woman doctor was attacked by a patient at a hospital in Tirupati.

The incident at Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS) was captured by a CCTV camera in the hospital. The CCTV footage shows the attacker grabbing the doctor by her hair and banging her head on the steel frame of a hospital bed. Others doctors in the ward immediately came to their colleague's rescue. The incident, she said, raises serious concerns about safety in workplace.

"If patient had been armed with a sharp weapon, the situation could have escalated with severe consequences," the doctor wrote, demanding security measures to ensure safety of staff. Following the

Hooda, who was Rajya sabha member, was recently elected to Lok Sabha from the Rohtak seat.

The bypoll was held for the remaining term of the Rajya Sabha seat as Deepender's term was to end in April 2026.

For record, in the House of 90, the ruling BJP in 2019 had won 40 seats, while the Congress secured 31 seats and Jannayak Janta Party (JJP), 10 seats. Smaller players - Indian National Lok Dal (INLD) and Haryana Lokhit Party (HLP) each won one seat while seven independent candidates had made it to the House.

BODIES OF 2 TEENAGE
GIRLS FOUND HANGING

In a tragic incident, the bodies of two teenage girls were found hanging from a tree in a mango orchard in Bhagoutipur village, Kaimganj Kotwali, on Tuesday morning.

The girls, identified as Shashi (16) and Babli (18), had gone to the village temple on Monday night to attend Jan-

mashtami celebrations but never returned home.

The gruesome discovery was made by a local woman who spotted the bodies hanging from a dupatta in the orchard early in the morning.

She immediately informed the families, who then alerted the police.

The police arrived at the scene, retrieved the bodies, and sent them for postmortem examination.

SHIVAJI STATUE
COLLAPSE

FIR against
sculptor,
consultant

The Sindhudurg Police booked the sculptor and the structural consultant of the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj statue at Rajkot Fort that collapsed on Monday.

The accused were booked under sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) related to attempt to commit homicide, act endangering the life or personal safety of others, attempt to murder, and cheating.

An FIR in the regard was filed on Monday night against sculptor Jaideep Apte, proprietor Artistry, and structural consultant Dr. Chetan S Patil, based on a complaint lodged by Ajit Patil, assistant engineer of Public Works Department.

Along with the State Government and concerned specialists, the Navy has deputed a team to immediately investigate the cause of this unfortunate accident and initiate steps to repair, restore, and reinstate the statue at the earliest," news agency ANI reported citing an Indian Navy's statement.

CM Shinde said the statue was designed and constructed by the Indian Navy.

The MP from Mandi in Himachal Pradesh had posted a clip of her interview with Hindi daily Dainik Bhaskar in which she suggested that a "Bangladesh-like situation" could have erupted in India but for the country's strong leadership.

She then alleged that bodies were hanging and rapes were taking place during the farmers' protest against the now-repealed three farm laws.

Cong announces
1st candidates' list;
BJP releases third

The Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections are proving to be an interesting affair with some of the major political parties announcing their list of candidates for the first phase of voting on the last day of filing of nominations on Tuesday.

The Congress on Tuesday announced its first list of candidates for the elections. It has fielded two former presidents of its Jammu and Kashmir unit. While Ghulam Ahmad Mir would be contesting from Dooru, Vikar Rasool Wani will be fighting for the Banihal seat.

The party has also fielded two non-Muslim candidates-Surinder Singh Channi from Tral and Dr Pradeep Kumar

Bhagat from Doda West.

The Congress had earlier forged an alliance with the National Conference for the polls. Under the seat-sharing agreement, it was decided that while Congress would contest 32 of the 90 seats, the National Conference would get a lion's share of 51. The parties had also left one seat each for the Communist Party of India (Marxist) and the Panthers Party and agreed to a 'friendly contest' on five seats on which they were unable to finalise a single candidate.

Meanwhile, the BJP, which had on Monday announced its first two lists of candidates, comprising a total of 16 candidates for the first phase of the polling 1, on Tuesday announced the third list of another 29 candidates.
