HYDERABAD: Cases were registered on Thursday by police here against Telangana Minister for Labour and Employment Ch Malla Reddy for allegedly obstructing duties of Income Tax officials during the searches carried out by them and also against an I-T official following a complaint by the Minister's son, police said.

Damp weather with drizzle hits normalcy in Bengaluru

BENGALURU: Damp weather with a drizzle partially paralysed normal life in Bengaluru on Thursday. The showers were due to a low pressure in the Bay of Bengal in coastal Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) recorded 3.4 mm of rainfall in the central region of Bengaluru and 5.2 mm rain in the international airport in the morning.

Maha: Leopard enters housing complex in Kalyan, injures three

THANE: Three people suffered minor injuries on Thursday after a leopard entered a housing complex in Kalyan in Maharashtra's Thane district, an official said. The big cat sneaked into the premises of Anurag Tower on Chinchpada Road in the morning, leaving panicked residents to call in forest department and police personnel, he said. "Three people sustained minor injuries and were given first-aid at a local hospital. The leopard has been kept captive and we are awaiting for a cage into which it will be shifted (for evacuation from the site)," Range Forest Officer Sanjay Channe told reporters.

63-year old man sentenced to life for raping minor

DHUBRI: A 63-year old man was sentenced to life imprisonment by a local court under the POCSO Act for raping a nine-year old girl. Dhubri Additional Session Judge Cum Special Judge (POCSO), Poli Katoki convicted and sentenced the man to rigorous imprisonment for life on Wednesday. The man was slapped with a fine of Rs 50,000 under Section 6 of the Act. The crime was committed eight months ago, when the child was alone at her home near here.

J&K: Mother, 4-yr-old son burnt alive after LPG catches fire

POONCH: A mother and her minor son were burnt alive after an LPG cylinder caught fire and exploded in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district on Thursday, officials said. The incident occurred in Chandimarh village of the Surankote subdivision. The deceased were identified as Hamida Begum (40) and Aqib Ahmed (4), police said. Three other family members, including the deceased woman's husband and two children, narrowly escaped in the blast and subsequent fire, they said.

Kanpur: 6 lose eyesight in cataract op, probe ordered

KANPUR: The Chief Medical Officer (CMO) in Uttar Pradesh's Kanpur Nagar district has ordered a probe against a nursing home in the city after six senior citizens lost their eyesight after being operated upon for cataract here. All six were recently operated at an eye-check up camp organised at the Aradhya nursing home. Six of those who were operated upon complained of loss of vision, headache and pain in the eyes. They claimed that they cannot see and that there was extreme pain in their eyes.

Killing spree: Man sentenced to death for murdering 5

AGARTALA: A court in Tripura's Khowai district sentenced a 40-year-old man to death for murdering five people, including his two daughters, elder brother, a police inspector and a passerby, in a killing spree last year. The court of District and Sessions Judge Sankari Das, after hearing the arguments, awarded capital punishment on Wednesday. "Initially, it appeared that Pradip Debroy was mentally ill but later doctors certified that he was mentally fit. The court passed the verdict in less than a year," government advocate Bikash Deb said.

PROJECT 15B

Indian Navy takes delivery of second missile destroyer

Mormugao, the second ship of Project 15B stealth guided missile destroyers being built at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd (MDL), was delivered to the Indian Navy on Thursday, defence officials said.

The ship is 163 metres long and 17 metres wide, displaces 7400 tonnes when fully loaded and has a maximum speed of 30 knots. Apart from my-

riad indigenous equipment in the 'Float' and 'Move' categories, the destroyer is also installed with major indigenous weapons. The overall indigenous content of the project is approximately 75 per cent, a Defence Ministry official said.

The Indian Navy said that the ship had sailed out for her maiden sea sortie on December 19 last year to coincide with the Goa Liberation Day and has now been delivered.

POLYGAMY AND NIKAH HALALA: SC will set up Bench to hear pleas

The Supreme Court said on Thursday it will set up a fresh five-judge Constitution bench to hear the pleas challenging the constitutional validity of polygamy and 'nikah halala' among Muslims.

A bench comprising Chief Justice D Y Chandrachud and Justices Hima Kohli and J B Pardiwala was urged by lawyer Ashwini Upadhyay, who has filed a PIL on the issue, that a fresh five-judge bench was needed to be constituted as two judges of the previous bench-Justice Indira Banerjee and Justice Hemant Gupta, Surya Kant, M M Sundresh and Sudhan-shu Dhulia had made the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), National Commission for Women (NCW) and the National Commission for Minorities (NCM) parties to the PILs and sought their responses.

Later, Justice Banerjee and Justice Gupta retired on September 23 and October 16 this year respectively giving rise to the need for re-constitution of the bench to hear as many as eight petitions against the practices of polygamy and 'nikah halala'.

Upadhyay, in his PIL, has sought a direction to declare polygamy and 'nikah halala' unconstitutional and illegal.

The apex court had in July 2018 considered the plea and referred the matter to a Constitution bench already tasked with hearing a batch of similar petitions.

The apex court had issued notice to the Centre on the petition filed by a woman named Farjana and tagged Upadhyay's plea to a batch of petitions to be heard by the Constitution bench.

MANGALURU BLAST

Islamic outfit claims responsibility Warns of another attack

"Alok Kumar your joy would be short lived. You pay for your acts of dominance sooner," the outfit warned

Islamic Resistance Council (IRC), an unknown Islamic outfit, on Thursday claimed responsibility for the November 19 Mangaluru autorickshaw blast and warned of another attack in future.

The outfit has also warned the ADGP (Law and Order), Alok Kumar, who is stationed at Mangaluru and personally monitoring the investigations into the blast case. "Alok Kumar your joy would be short lived. You pay for your acts of dominance sooner," the outfit warned. The police sources have confirmed that they have taken the warning seriously. The probe in this regard has already been initiated by Central agencies.

Meanwhile, the probe revealed that the suspected terrorist Mohammad Shariq was planning to carry out explosion at Kadri Manjunatha Swamy temple 'Laksh Deepotsav' programme in Mangaluru.

Gokarnanatheshwara temple in Kudroli and Mangaladevi temple in Mangaluru were also his targets. The accused had kept the picture of Hindu God Shiva as his display picture on his mobile to conceal his identity, he said. The probe has also revealed that the conspiracy was hatched to carry out blasts and put blame on Hindu organisations and to start debate on Hindu terrorism in the country.

A post has been put out on dark net by an Islamic outfit by the name Islamic Resistance Council (IRC) supporting the terror suspect of Mangaluru blast on Thursday. The investigating agencies have taken this development seriously and further intensified operations to get to the roots of terror network.

No transfer of Justice Kariel from Gujarat HC

Gujarat High Court Justice Nikhil Kariel was not on the list of seven High Court judges recommended for transfer by the Supreme Court collegium on Thursday, according to online reports.

Last week, members of the Gujarat High Court Advocates Association had staged a protest and decided to abstain from work on November 17 after the collegium proposed to transfer Kariel to the Patna High Court. According to reports, "Justice Kariel is one of the finest, honest, upright and unbiased Judge whose integrity and honesty is being vouched by the entire Bar in one voice," the association had said in a resolution.

On Thursday, while the collegium's list did not include Kariel's name, it recommended Raja's and Reddy's transfer as proposed earlier.

Delhi HC: Courts must consider 'aftermath' of rape incidents

The Delhi High Court has said an accused should not be discharged of the offence of rape merely because the victim had not levelled the allegation at the stage of the FIR.

Justice Swarna Kanta Sharma said the victim's statement before a magistrate disclosing the offence of rape shall be sufficient to frame charges under section 376 (punishment for rape) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and courts must consider the "aftermath" of such an incident, which causes physical and emotional trauma to the victim and that at times, she might not be in an emotional or physical state to take an immediate stand against the assailant.

The judge emphasised that the victim's statement should be viewed from a considerate and liberal perspective at the time of framing charges and an "overzealous approach" to conclude the entire case by appreciating evidence even before it begins is fatal to the case as well as to justice and the faith of the victim.

"Many a times, a person may not be in an emotional or physical state to take an immediate stand against the assailant or to go through further trauma of investigation by the police or through an intrusive medical examination, and an accused should not merely be discharged under section 376 because the prosecutrix has not stated about the same in her FIR or during MLC (medico-legal case)," the court said in its order dated November 23. "An overzealous approach to appreciate evidence in detail and conclude the entire case even before it begins is fatal not only to the case at hand, but, at times, to justice and the faith of the victim in the criminal justice system," it added.

Guj HC holds Morbi officer behind bridge collapse

Gujarat High Court Chief Justice Arvind Kumar on Thursday held Morbi Nagar palika Chief Officer S.V. Zala responsible for the October 30 bridge collapse which claimed 135 lives. "The Morbi Nagar palika Chief Officer S.V.Zala is prima facie guilty of dereliction of duty and even the affidavit filed by the nagar palika lacks details," a division bench of Chief Justice Arvind Kumar and Justice A.J. Shastri observed.

It also sought a detailed report on similar bridges in the state and its status report within 10 days and initiated suo motu public interest litigation in the incident.

During the hearing, the court opined, "We are not satisfied with the compensation amount paid to the families of deceased, a family should get at least Rs 10 lakh compensation."

The court was annoyed to see castes mentioned against the names of some of the deceased.

'No woman in Jama Masjid' order withdrawn

Jama Masjid's Shahi Imam has agreed to withdraw the order restricting entry of women in the mosque, after Delhi LG V K Saxena spoke to him and requested him to take back the decree, Raj Niwas sources said on Thursday.

They added that Imam Bukhari agreed to revoke the order, on the condition that visitors respect and maintain the sanctity of the mosque. The administration of Delhi's famed Jama Masjid had put up notices outside the main gates banning the entry of 'girls', whether alone or in groups. As controversy escalated, the mosque's Shahi Imam on Thursday said the order is not applicable to those coming to offer prayers.

The issue led to an outrage in some quarters as women rights activists termed the mosque's decision regressive and unacceptable.

The notices, which have no date, came up a few days ago outside the three main entry gates, sources in the administration said. However, it has come to attention only now.

"Jama Masjid mein ladkiya ladkiyon ka akele daakhla mana hai (The entry of a girl, or girls is not permitted in Jama Masjid)," reads the notice by the administration of the 17th century Mughal era monument that attracts thousands of devout as well as tourists.

MLA POACHING CASE: SIT issues notice to MP

HYDERABAD: In a new twist to MLAs' poaching case, the Special Investigation Team (SIT) has served notice to K. Raghurama Krishna Raju, rebel MP of YSR Congress Party (YSRCP).

The SIT probing the sensational case has issued the notice under section 41A of Criminal Procedure Code.

The MP has been directed to appear before SIT officials in Hyderabad on November 29.

The probe team is reportedly looking to gather some key information relating to the case from Raju.

The MP, however, told media persons that he has still not received any notice. "If the notice comes, I will decide my future course of action," he said when asked if he would challenge it in the court of law.

He is the seventh person to be summoned by the SIT for questioning.
