Former world championship silver medallist Jyothi Surekha Vennam won the individual gold in the women's compound section in the Archery World Cup Stage 1 here on Saturday.

Jyothi prevailed over former world champion Sara Lopez of Colombia 149-146 to claim her second gold of the tournament.She and her debutant partner Ojas Deotale had earlier in the day prevailed over Chinese Taipei 159-154 in the compound mixed team event to open In-

dia's medal account. The win also avenged Jyothi's World Championship final loss to the Colombian opponent when the Indian had settled for a silver, going down 144-146 at Yankton 2021. Adelaide: Talor Gooch upstaged the more-fancied names on the LIV Golf tour by shooting a 10-under 62 to take a fourstroke lead after the first round of the inaugural Australian tournament at The Grange. The 31-year-old American on Friday started with a par on his opening hole in the shotgunstart format - the par-3 12th - but then had 10 birdies, including five in a row. Two more players in the unfancied category - Richard Bland and Dean Burmester - shot 66s and were tied for second. Five players were tied for fourth, including Danny Lee, who won the second LIV event in Arizona in mid-March.
