

State sees Covid cases, one fatality, active tally 744

Bhopal: The Covid tally in Madhya Pradesh reached 10,44,917 on Tuesday after the detection of 98 cases, while the death toll increased by one to touch 10,744, a health official said. The positivity rate, or cases detected per 100 tests, stood at 1.8 per cent, he added. The recovery count increased by 81 to touch 10,33,429, leaving the state with 744 active cases, the official informed. With 5,215 samples examined during the day, the number of coronavirus tests in MP went up to 2,95,36,136, he added. A government release said 12,06,18,537 COVID-19

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On the occasion of Van Mahotsav, faculty and students of Daly College of Business Management made an attempt to make nature green with seed bombs. Environmentalists VS Pal and Anshu Pal trained the faculty, staff and daily wage workers to make seed balls. Welcoming the guests, principal Sonal Sisodia in her address said that in such times a new technique, which is called seed bombing will definitely help in making the city green. The experts shared that seed bombing is actually an aerial reforestation technique. It is a technique meant to introduce vegetation by throwing seed balls on barren land. With this technique, people can help afforestation without spending much time on it and they can also have fun on the run. They said that one needs to find an open area where one could

spread the seed bombs. Those who really want to contribute to our environment can carry seed bombs even on long tours. While driving to different places, people come across several barren lands or river banks where they can throw these seed bombs. It can also be a part of your gardening routine. These seed bombs can be preserved for a longer time and used when you travel. However, one must consider the fact that the seeds should be native to the place. If the grass is thick one might have to clear a small patch to place the seed bomb on. The next heavy rain starts the process. Until then the clay keeps the insects, rain or wind from carrying away your seeds. A heavy rain dissolves the clay away enough to get the seed to germinate and take root in the soil below, feeding meanwhile on the compost that is part of the mixture.

Polling for 11 municipal corporations, 36 municipalities, 86 city councils today

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The first phase of polling in the urban body election will be held on Wednesday from 7 am to 5 pm. All preparations have been completed for peaceful polling. Voters should exercise their voting rights without fear, appealed State Election Commissioner Basant Pratap Singh on Tuesday. Polling teams have reached the designated polling stations. In the first phase, polling will be held in 11 municipal corporations, 36 municipalities and 86 city councils in 44 districts. A total of 13,148 polling stations have been set up. Of these, 3,296 polling stations are sensitive. About 79,000 government employees have been deployed for polling duty in the state. About 27,000 po-

licemen have been put on job, said Singh. In the first phase, 101 candidates are in the fray for the post of mayor. There are 2,850 posts of councillors in 133 urban bodies. Out of these, 42 posts have been elected unopposed. Election is to be held on the remaining 2,808 posts. For this, 11,250 candidates are

contesting the elections. In the first phase, 1.4 crore people will cast vote. Out of these 53,62,457 are males and 50,78,635 are females and 805 other voters. There are 10,68,267 voters in Gwalior municipal limit, 2,22,584 in Sagar, 2,14,188 in Satna, 2,05,886 in Singrauli, 9,76,061 in Jabalpur, 1,90,742 in Chhindwara,

17,06,735 in Bhopal, 1,75,644 in Khandwa, 1,77,666 in Burhanpur, 18,35,955 in Indore and 4,61,169 voters in Ujjain municipal limit. The maximum numbers of voters are in Indore and the least number of voters are in Khandwa municipal limit. The state government has declared a public holiday on July 6.

AHEAD OF CIVIC POLLS  
SEIZED: 1,300 unlicensed arms, liquor worth Rs 5.8 cr

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Over 1,300 unlicensed weapons have been seized and preventive action has been taken against more than 1.73 lakh persons ahead of the urban local bodies elections in Madhya Pradesh, an official said on Tuesday. The two-phase local bodies elections in the state for 413 municipalities, including 16 Nagar Palika Nigams, 99 Nagar Palika Parishads and 298 Nagar Parishads will be held on July 6 and July 13. The administration has seized 1,349 unlicensed weapons and ensured that over 2.58 lakh licensed arms holders deposit their weapons in the nearest police stations to maintain law and order during the



polls, the official said. Apart from this, action has been taken against 1,73,714 persons under the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC) and 20,984 non-bailable arrest warrants have also been executed, the official said. The administration also seized 51,366 litres of liquor worth over Rs 5.82 crore, including 13,096 litres in Dhar district alone, the official added. (INPUTS FROM AGENCY)

HC directs CBI probe into fake DNA test

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High Court's principal bench, Jabalpur, has instructed the state government for CBI or STF probe in the fake DNA report in connection with the murder incident reported on May 16, 2021, according to the advocate of accused. Two accused Sandip Thakur and Anshu Thakur were arrested. Sickles, other arms and clothes were recovered. Samples were sent for DNA test.

Advocate Nitin Dubey, who appeared on behalf of the accused, said that the "Superintendent of Police (SP) Jabalpur informed the court that he received report on June 6, 2021 as it was sent RPSL, Jabalpur, on June 10, 2021 to verify whether it is human blood or not. While the investigating officer (IO) reported to the HC that he sent samples on June 23, 2021 for DNA test in Bhopal. The constable on the other hand reported that he left a draft in Bhopal on June 23, 2021.

Bring all pvt schools under RTE Act: MPCPCR to school edu minister

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The Madhya Pradesh Commission for Protection of Child Rights (MPCPCR) has recommended to the Madhya Pradesh government to bring all private schools in the state, including minority educational institutions, under the Right to Education (RTE) Act. The government can make a rule to do it, he said. The commission has written a letter to the minister for school education

Inder Singh Parmar making a recommendation to this effect. It may be mentioned here that minority educational institutions are exempted from the ambit of the RTE Act and are not mandatorily required to admit students under the RTE. Member of the commission Brajesh Chauhan told Free Press that many leading private schools were using the stratagem of ensuring that a majority of the members in the school management committees were from the minority communities. "This should stop," he said. He further said that there

are 30,000 private schools in the state. Of these, 26,000 private schools are required to give admissions

to children of eligible families under the RTE. There are still 4,000 private schools in the state which don't come under the RTE. Out of these 4000 schools, around 2,000 schools have been closed during the Covid-19 pandemic. "We want that the remaining 2000 schools should be brought under RTE so that the dream of parents from poor backgrounds, making a living by selling tea or cleaning utensils etc. can be fulfilled and their children can also acquire quality education in leading and good schools," Chauhan said.

Conference on New Education Policy
